GENERAL

The Junior School Enrichment Teacher is responsible for identifying those students and designing differentiated programs that will challenge and enhance their learning. The Enrichment teacher consults with teachers, advises parents and monitors the progress of students in the program.

ACCOUNTABILITY

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Consultation

 - Help plan differentiated schoolwork for students who require enrichment in various subject areas.
 - Monitor the implementation of the differentiated schoolwork
 - Provide resources in the area of enrichment to teachers
 - Liaise with the Coordinator of Teaching and Learning (Junior School)

2. Individual Student Management

- Create a list of target students through school data and consultation with teachers
- Meet with individual students to ascertain their interest, abilities and develop an individual learning plan
- Run program support group meetings for the parents and teachers of individual students
- Report to parents on student progress at Parent-Teacher Interviews and in school reports.
- Conduct small group activities in year levels when required

3. Campus Related

- Display student work (in classrooms/corridors/assembly hall) and collect work, as appropriate, for inclusion in the Harp or Year Book.
- Demonstrate involvement in the life of the School including festivals, commemorations, sports days and other special events (inc. camps and assemblies).
- Contribute to the development of the School through initiating or assisting with the development of new programs
- Contribute to the co-curricular life of the School
